

Dr. Costas Alexandrou

Constantinos Alexandrou, graduated in 1985 – with Papadakis Foundation Scholarship – from the Medical School of Athens. He then continued his education in General Surgery in Public and Private Greek hospitals.

In 1992 he was given a 4 year scholarship by the Japanese Ministry of Education so as to be trained in Plastic Surgery. At the University of Kagawa in Japan he specialized in congenital malformations (cleft lip palate, microtia), in reconstructive microsurgery and in aesthetic surgery (blepharoplasty, rhinoplasty, otoplasty). Dr Alexandrou scientific journey continued in the USA when in 1996 he accepted a Craniofacial Surgery Fellowship from Professor Joe McCarthy of New York University. There, he received specialized training in sectors such as the handling of craniofacial malformations and orthognathic surgeries, with extensive application in aesthetic surgery.

During his stay in the United States, Dr Alexandrou was trained in New York, in many high reputation medical establishments such as Tisch Hospital, Bellevue Hospital and Manhattan Eye Ear and Throat. Alongside with his training in Craniofacial Surgery he specialized in aesthetic surgery techniques, lifting, rhinoplasty, abdominoplasty, liposuction, increase/reduction and reconstruction of the breast.

After returning to Greece, he began his carrier at the Hellenic Craniofacial Center under the guidance and support of his mentor, the late Dr Alexandros Stratoudakis, who appreciating his professional ethics, his scientific training and his surgical abilities, he trusted him with the continuation of his own goals.

Today Dr Alexandrou is the Director of the only Craniofacial Center in Greece, which is one of the only 9 recognised in Europe. From this position he continues his activities in the field of craniofacial but also the aesthetic surgery.

Dr Alexandrou respecting the individuality of the patient and the specificity of his needs, targets always to the best natural result for his case. Pledge of the whole effort is the assiduous and thorough treatment that is provided always with distinguished hospitals.

In the scientific field, he has a large number of scientific studies, presentations and lectures, and also articles that have been published in Greece and abroad.
